#### Mathematics Department Level Change Requirements and Student Profile

The Level Change process is for students currently in Grades 6 and 7. Students may not complete the Level Change process or the Credit by Exam process more than once.

## \*\*Applications can be turned in after April 1. Must be received by June 1\*\*

### I. Level Change Process.

A student may change levels without completing the full year of course work of study for such class, if based on the student's past academic performance, it is determined that the student will benefit academically by exercising this alternative. The student will need to achieve a score of **at least 85 percent** on the appropriate local exam and complete a special project (portfolio) to demonstrate proficiency, in such knowledge, skills and abilities normally developed in the course.

#### II. Criteria for acceptance.

The level change process will allow a student to complete 40 weeks of course material in a six to eight week period. For a student to be successful they must have a proven academic achievement at an honors level (multiple A+ grades on the report card), as well as a strong recommendation by their classroom teacher. It has been our experience that students who did not achieve a high "A" average through previous coursework and NWEA scores above 90% are not successful in the level change process and the preparation to move forward in accelerated courses.

The Mathematics Department of Niskayuna High School required that the student applying for a level change comply with all of the following:

#### I The Tutor...

- 1. The tutor can be a mathematics educator certified by the New York State Education Department, and will be subject to the approval of the Director of mathematics.
- 2. The student will supply the director with the name, address and telephone number of the proposed tutor.
- 3. The Director will work with the tutor to create a plan and proposed outline for the completion of the level change course. This plan should include the chapters to be covered, a tentative timeline for completion, and arrangements for student completion of chapter tests.

#### II The Project...

The student will compile a portfolio of the work done to complete the level change course. The portfolio will include:

- 1. an outline of all work assigned for each chapter.
- 2. a minimum of 5 completed assignments from each chapter. These assignments should be organized by chapter and be clearly labeled to indicate chapter, page, and problem numbers.
- assignments that show mastery of the chapter's concepts at a variety of cognitive levels (i.e., not all "A" type examples). All student work must be shown in a neat and organized manner.
- 4. the tests for each chapter. These tests will have been administered under test conditions. The student will show all work as evidence of the methods used in solving. The test will be corrected by the tutor with a test grade clearly visible on the paper.

#### III Additional Considerations...

Student Signature

- 1. The student must complete, to the satisfaction of his present teacher, the work for the class in which he is presently enrolled.
- 2. The director will make the final decision on the placement of the student based upon:
  - a. quality of the work presented in the portfolio and included tests.
  - b. grade on the local exam *taken during the August Regents Examination time*,
  - c. previous academic record and standardized test scores.
